Open It Up

- Is it easy or hard for you to want to go to church? Why?
- What was a bad habit that you were able to break? How did that make you feel?
- When/How can you tell when someone's love is "real"? What does "real love" look like? Act like? Sound like?

Dig In Deeper

- When we know something is "bad" why, at times, do we "linger" with (or long for) that thing rather than just leaving it behind?
- Tell of a time that you really realized the repercussions of a sin. Was that a painful realization or a liberating one - or both? Why?
- Why is it so important to replace the "bad" with the "good"? How have you seen this work out practically in your life?
- Why do you think Paul was so emphatic about making sure our love is real ("without dissimulation").

Think It Through

- What is a sin that you need to stop "longing for" and start to hate so you can leave it behind? Pray that the Lord will help you in this area.
- Who can you "connect with" this week to help you replace the things you have left behind - the "evil that you hate" with something good?
- Right now, is your love for others with or without dissimulation? What can you do to make sure your love is real and genuine?
