Open It Up

- What are some "wells" in your life that have been filled in?

Think It Through

- What is an area in your life that could qualify as a "border town" where the Lord is encouraging you to come back to Him?
- When you have those moments where you think your mistakes and/or sins decrease your value in Christ, find five promises in God's Word that can correct your thinking?
- What steps can you take this week to unstop the "wells" of your life?
- What are some of the most precious promises of God that you hold on to during tough times? Thank the Father for those promises today.
- Do you really view hardships and mistakes as God's guiding hand in your life? If so - what has made that a real truth to you? If not, what promise(s) do you need to grab hold of to change your view of God's working in your life?
