#### Think It Through

- Of the points that Pastor Matt brought up in today's teaching, which is the most difficult for you to help you live in harmony: Don't be haughty, Readily adjust to people, Readily adjust to things/surprises, Giving yourself to humble tasks or Don't overestimate yourself
