Dig In Deeper

- What are some of the benefits of our freedom in Christ? Are there disadvantages? Explain.

Think It Through

- What are some convictions the Lord has given to you personally (your “list”) that you have put onto others?
- In Matthew 15:8-9 it tells us that when we teach the commandments of men and teaching them as the doctrine of God (putting a stop sign where God has only put a caution sign) and because of that we make empty the worship of God. How does that make you feel? What are some occasions where you’ve done that to yourself? To others?
- What are some topics in your life where you have deferred to a list rather than depended on the Lord? What lists do you need to get rid of in your life?
