#### Open It Up

- When was a time that you were a “goof ball” and were embarrassed/ashamed?
- How would you define “shame”?

#### Dig In Deeper

- Which “crop of shame” do you find yourself stuck in most frequently: Fear, Isolation, Lying or Masks? How much do you think it is based on the reason you’re ashamed? Why?
- Which source of shame do you feel you struggle with the most: Sin, Slightings, Shortcomings, Stupidity or Circumstances? Why? What would you tell someone who struggled with the area of shame?
- What is an “I’ll never...” pledge that you’ve made, only to later struggle with it again?
- What was a mistake you’ve made and suffered the consequences of that mistake?
- What is a circumstance in your life that you feel disadvantaged? What promises from Scripture can you use to overcome it?

#### Think It Through

- Why do we have a hard time accepting the fact that Jesus still loves us, in spite of our mistakes? What is a truth from scripture that reminds us of and can give a correct understanding of the Father’s love for us?
- What is a situation where you can offer comfort to someone in an area where you have previously been comforted by God? (2 Cor. 1:4) Is there anything that keeps you from offering that comfort?
- How does the power of Communion help us not be ashamed? Be specific.
