Bible Questions & Application

 - b. What does it take to maintain trust in any relationship?
4. What are some ways you are being fruitful (biblically) in your own life?
5. Discuss this quote: “The worst possible thing you can do is to allow them to stay selfish.” What do you think this means? Can you think of any examples of this?
6. “We need mission to be doing good.” How does a missional lifestyle promote goodness?
