1. How did Sunday's message challenge your thinking?

3. A person can be born again as a Christian but still not grasp the true nature of God. How can this be possible, and what can we do about it?
4. What lies from the enemy have influenced the way you think God views you?
  - a. Is there a painful life experience or season from which this lie originated?
  - b. What biblical truth can you exchange for this lie?
5. When was the last time you let someone see the real you? Do you want to be seen?
  - a. Can you be truly loved without being truly seen? Discuss.
  - b. What keeps us from being vulnerable with God and with others?
6. "Our # 1 job is to be loved by God."
  - a. Does this challenge your idea of a Christian's main purpose?
  - b. What distractions or circumstances can make us forget that we're loved by God?
7. What would it look like if we always remembered to live in forgiveness?
