- 1. Zacchaeus could not see Jesus, so he climbed a tree to find Him.
 - a. Are there any obstacles you may personally need to overcome in order to draw closer to Jesus?
 - b. When was the last time you went "out on a limb" for Jesus?
- 2. Jesus was very compelling to Zacchaeus. What is compelling about Jesus to you today?
- 3. In what ways am I presently encouraging/discouraging other believers?
- 4. How can I, as a part of the "crowd", help the marginalized to climb the tree?
 - a. Is there a Zacchaeus (seeker) in your circle of life?
 - b. What are you doing to encourage them?
- 5. Wherever Jesus goes salvation breaks out. How has salvation affected . . .
 - a. Your home?
 - b. You socially?
 - c. You economically?
- 6. The crowd disapproved of Jesus's acceptance of Zacchaeus because Jesus displayed scandalous grace. How can I/we display grace like that?
