## **Bible Summary**

Injustice Psalm 73

The praise leader Asaph looks at the success of the wicked and becomes envious. His faith starts to slip and he questions why he tries so hard to be righteous yet suffers while the wicked get the easy life. His answer comes when he meets God in the Sanctuary.

Scriptures – Genesis 2:15-17; Ecclesiastes 9:11; Hebrews 4:12

- 1. What does it mean to be pure in heart?
- 2. What is it about other people's prosperity that's so attractive to us?
  - a. Share about a time when you caught yourself envying someone else's seemingly picture-perfect life.
- 3. Have you ever felt like all your honest, hard work is useless? What is the root cause of this feeling?
- 4. Why do you go to church?
- 5. Share about a time when the sanctuary was a place of revelation for you personally.
  - a. Is there a difference between attending church or watching it online?
- 6. In the sanctuary Asaph got real with God and spoke his mind. Does the idea of speaking frankly with God scare you?
- 7. What does it mean when Asaph says God is his "portion" forever (v. 26)?
  - a. How does knowing this help us navigate through our struggles?
- 8. Do you think it's wrong to doubt God?
  - a. Why or why not?
  - b. As believers, what should we do with our doubts and fears?
