Identity

Psalm 8

Psalm 8 is a positive, brilliant text on God and His masterpiece: humans. We may have been taught that humans are worthless heaps of junk. Nothing is further from the truth. We have a glory and majesty reflective of God Himself, and Psalm 8 poetically presses this reality into our minds.

Scriptures – John 3:16; Genesis 1:26-28; Hebrews 2:6-10
