Scripture – Psalm 8; Hebrews 2:6-10; Proverbs 22:6

Community Group Questions:

Introduction

- Why is there such an identity crisis in our culture?
- For hundreds of years people used to get their identity from their tribe, career, family and religion.

Culture Says

- “Culture says, if you don’t know what/who you are, we will tell you.” What are the dangers of listening to what culture says about us?
- How are people identified by the things they own?
- How do you acknowledge what you feel without sacrificing your identity?
- “Your words create your identity.”

God Says (Psalm 8)

- “Our identity starts with God; the more you know about God, the more you will understand who you are.”
- As an image barrier we take chaos and create order. What are some examples from your life of creating order?
- How does gathering in community help us exemplify God’s character?
- “We were created just south of Divinity.”
- (v 5) When God looks at us he sees kavod: heaviness; honor, glory; honor, majestic, glory, splendor; abundance, riches. How does this impact you?

Jesus Goal (Hebrews 2:6-10)

- Why do we as Christian struggle with who God says we are?
- How does Jesus bringing glory to His sons and daughters affect your identity?
- Have you let Jesus restore you back to glory?
