Matthew 5:27-30

Summary – Every good and perfect gift comes from the Father. Humanity has taken these good gifts and instead of enjoying them, we have abused them. Sex is one such gift that we have turned into lust and Jesus says it turns the gift into a living hell. His solution is to cut off any avenue that opens our lives toward lust.
