# Essential Jesus for Unsettled Days – Back to Basics Prayer

### Colossians 1:9-14

Summary: In a culture of shortcuts and life hacks, Scripture confronts us with a time tested slow path to maturity that offers no shortcuts but promises transformation. Colossians begins with two of the basics of our faith: Thanks and Prayer.

### **Pattern of Prayer**

- "Our job is to pray...it's God's job to do whatever He wants to do."
- "We are to pray with audacity." (Luke 11:5-13)

# Ask for Knowledge, Wisdom and Understanding
