Summary: For two millennia people have questioned: Who is Jesus? Was He a prophet, teacher, sage, or the Son of God? Colossians dives deep into the nature and personhood of Jesus Christ and unabashedly declares His divinity.

Scripture – Luke 19:1-10, 7:36-40; Jeremiah 31:9; Psalm 89:20, 27; Isaiah 40:26; Job 38:1-7; 1 John 2:19

Image/Icon (Colossians 1:15)

- Why is it important to see Jesus as 100% God and 100% man?
- What can we learn from Jesus' treatment of sinners? (Luke 19:1-10, 7:36-40)

Firstborn (Colossians 1:15)

- "If you have seen the Son, you have seen the Father."
- How does viewing the word firstborn as status and not birth order help you understand Jesus' divinity?

Sustainer (Colossians 1:17)

- What holds the universe and keeps it from spinning apart?

Before (Colossians 1:17)

- What is the importance of Jesus being above all things and before all things?

Resurrected King (Colossians 1:18-19)

- "The best proof we have that Jesus is King is His disciples."

Reconciler (Colossians 1:20-23)

- "Every single one of us has damaged God's property."
- "Once a pickle, never a cucumber again." (1 John 2:19)
- What's the spiritual significance of being "in Christ?"
