Pressing Onward (v.12-16)

- It's easy to lose spiritual focus. How do we prevent this?
- "Attitude truly is everything." What are the challenges/benefits of changing your mindset/perspective?
- What are the attributes of a mature Christian?
- "Besiege the past, starve it out." How does replaying your past keep you in a spiritual wilderness?
- "We should never spiritually retire."

Pressing Upward (v.17-21)

- What does it mean to be a citizen of Heaven and how should that influence us?
- How does your life follow your mind?
- "Our culture, our rule, our allegiance should come from Christ."
- "You are not alone as a Christian." How does this give you hope?
- "Hope gets you out of the prisons of the past."
- "Living in the past prevents you from living by faith." (Hebrews 11:6)
