Introduction

- What does it mean to be sober minded?

Battle (v. 8)

- What steps do you take to put on the Armor of God everyday?
- Why is Satan called the accuser? How has he accused you? How do you combat his accusations?

- "Christianity has always been a 'use your brain' religion." How do you protect yourself from having a "fit body and a fat mind?"
