Hope Returns

2 Thessalonians 2:1-12 Antichrist

Summary: 2 Thessalonians charges out of the gate by discussing two of the scariest subjects in Scripture: hell and the antichrist. Both of these frightening subjects carry a message of hope for the church experiencing a sampling of hell and antichrist-like figures.

Scripture – 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12; Revelation 9, 17:14; Matthew 24:12; 1 Timothy 4:1-3; 2 Timothy 3:1-4, Jude 18-19; 1 John 2:18; 2 Corinthians 6:16, 2:14; Psalm 106:15; Romans 8:37; 1 Corinthians 15:57

- 1- How does focusing on Christ overcome the fear of the antichrist?
- 2- How do you navigate the moral drift of society?
- 3- What comes to mind when you hear Paul say the Lord will "gather" us?
- 4- "The power of the antichrist has been at work for the last 2000 years."
- 5- Why do we focus at times on identifying the antichrist?
- 6- How have you personally been challenged by moral relativism (no objective truth)?
- 7- "Satan will heal your body to damn your soul."
- 8- "Whatever you believe you will be living.".
- 9- What would be the purpose of God sending them "strong delusion"?
- 10- "We're like Dorothy in the Wizard of Oz; we've had the shoes on from the beginning."
