2 Thessalonians 2:13-3:5 Unmovable

Summary: After discussing two difficult subjects of hell and the Antichrist, Paul offers a practical guide to staying strong in the face of intense persecution.

Scripture – 2 Thessalonians 2:13-3:5; Hebrews 4:16; Jeremiah 6:16; 1 Corinthians 15:58, 16:13; Philippians 4:1; 1 Thessalonians 3:8; Genesis 5:20

Chosen (2 Thessalonians 2:13)

“If you know who you are, you’ll know what to do.” How should knowing we are adopted citizens of God’s nation, a royal priesthood, affect how we live?

Be About Your Future Glory (2 Thessalonians 2:14)

Jesus inaugurated a new kingdom. What does it mean to be about your future glory?

Stand Firm (2 Thessalonians 2:15)

“Whatever scripture commands, we are capable of.” How does journaling and memorizing scripture help us stand firm?

“Don’t doubt in the night what God has shown us in the light.”

Hold Fast (2 Thessalonians 2:15)

“If you want to be immovable, hold fast to the scriptures.” Why would we want to follow the ancient path?

Good Works and Words (2 Thessalonians 16:17)

What are the challenge/benefits of balancing your good works and words?

Know J.O.Y. (2 Thessalonians 3:1-3)

J.O.Y. = Jesus, others, yourself. How do you learn to get your eyes off yourself?.

Obey (2 Thessalonians 3:4-5)

“In life you only have 2 choices, to obey or disobey.”

How can making a goal when you’re strong, help you keep it when you're weak?

In what ways are you obedient/disobedient in what God has called you to do?
